Guidelines for COVID 19

Send home or advise to stay home if the staff or student has:

2

Of the following:
Fever of 100
Headache
Body Aches
Chills
Sore Throat
New taste or smell dysfunction

Of the following:
New or Worsening
Cough
Shortness of Breath
Difficulty Breathing

Been exposed to someone diagnosed with COVID-19 [like family members]
*see exclusionary flowchart for definition of "exposure"

When can the staff or student return to school?

POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST

May return 10 days after symptoms first appeared or from first positive test date
AND
At least 24 hours no fever without taking fever reducing medicine
AND
Symptoms have improved

NO COVID-19 TEST

May return 10 days after symptoms first appeared
AND
At least 24 hours no fever without taking fever reducing medicine
AND
Symptoms have improved
OR
Doctor note indicating alternate diagnosis

NEGATIVE COVID-19 TEST

At least 24 hours no fever without taking fever reducing medicine
AND
Symptoms have improved

EXPOSURE COVID-19

May return 14 days after last exposure (or lab confirmed positive person began having symptoms)
AND
No symptoms

If you're sending a student home using this guidance, send exclusionary pass when parent picks up student
